# Good News from the UN HLP Report

## ENSURE GOOD GOVERNANCE AND EFFECTIVE INSTITUTIONS

- a) Provide free and universal legal identity, such as birth registrations
- b) Ensure that people enjoy freedom of speech, association, peaceful protest and access to independent media and information
- c) Increase public participation in political processes and civic engagement at all levels
- d) Guarantee the public's right to information and access to government data
- e) Reduce bribery and corruption and ensure officials can be held accountable

## Challenge

- Quality of Water Resources being affected by illegal, irresponsible discharge of non treated or toxic wastes
- Conflicting / competing interests of stakeholders leading to inappropriate water management practices
- Quality and cost of service delivery to the poor unsatisfactory

## River Basins

- GWP promoting best practices through RBOs and TBOs
- Currently consolidating ANBO

## Water Security And Climate Change

- WACDEP Program scaling up best practices, capacity building and defining investment plans

## GWP Network

- GWP has established partnerships with 13 Regions and 83 countries
