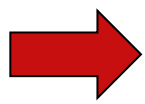

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## Background

- Corruption vulnerabilities are often caused by underlying governance weaknesses
- Corruption risks can be addressed explicitly or implicitly, depending on the context
- GIZ supports water sector governance reforms in many countries
- GIZ needs to maintain its role as honest broker.

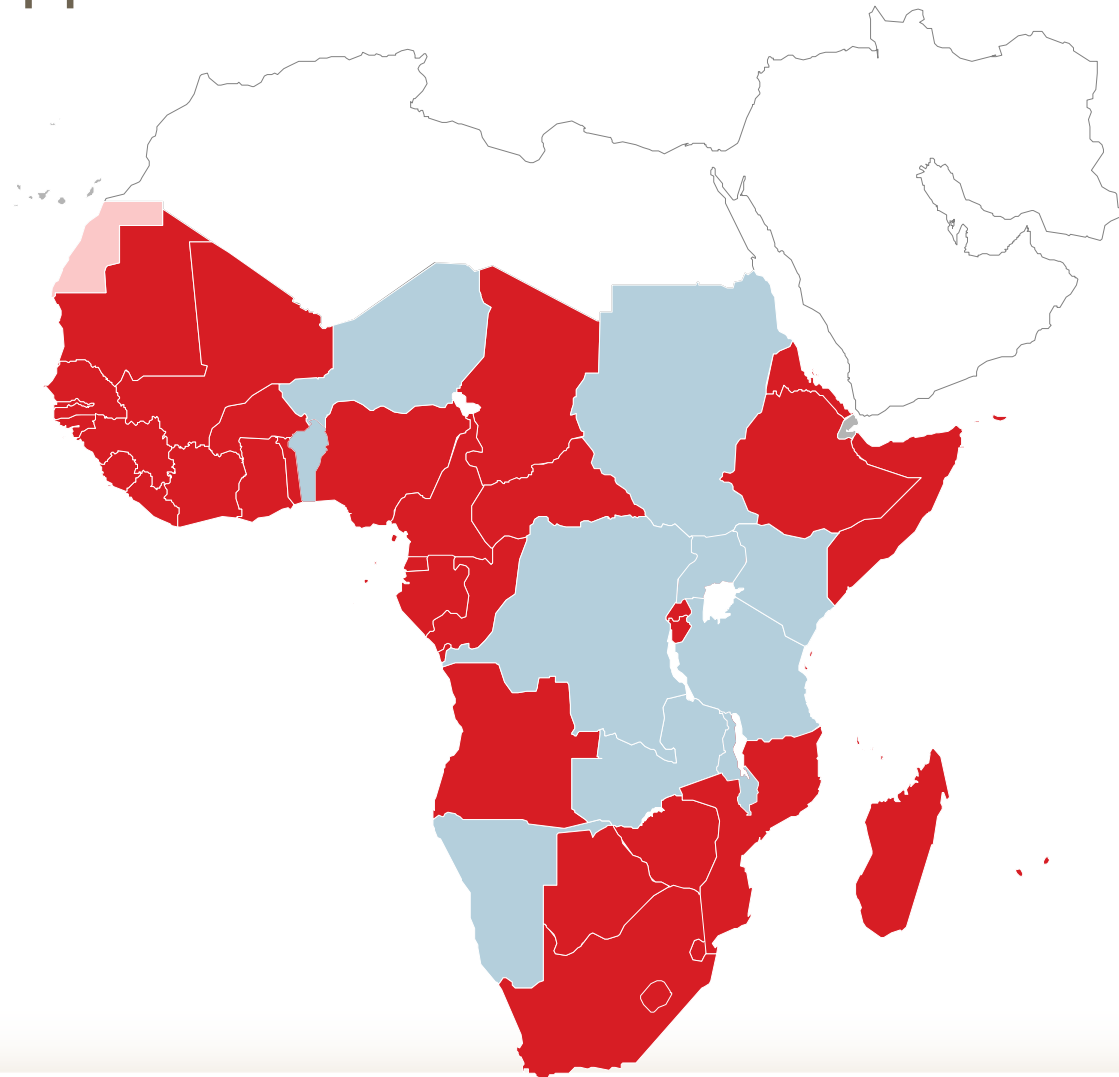


There are many options to reduce corruption opportunities through transparency, accountability, participation and integrity



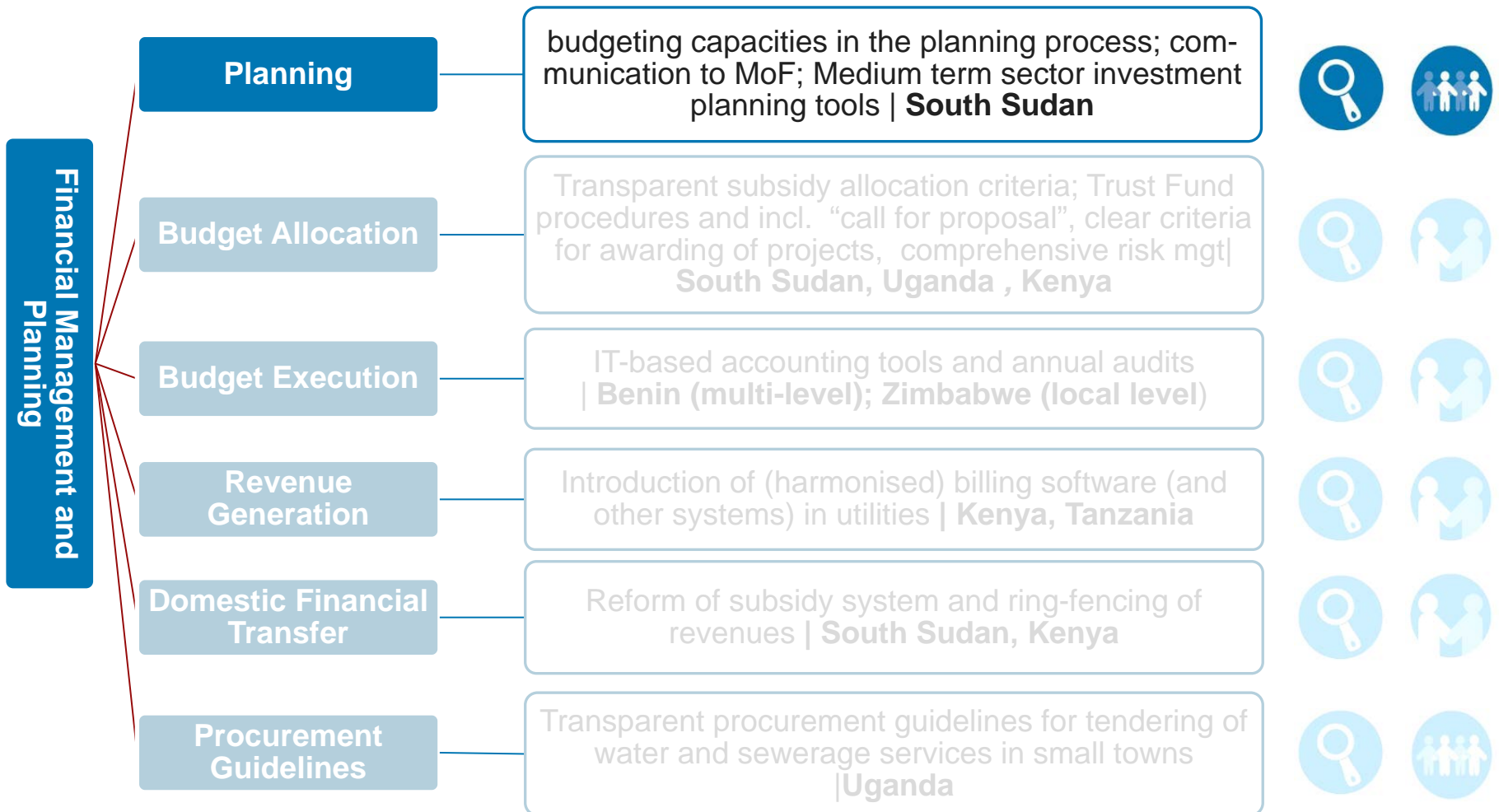
# Survey on existing approaches

- Survey conducted May – August 2012
- Covering data from 13 bilateral programmes in Sub-Saharan Africa
- 44 tools/approaches identified
- Clear tendency towards implicit approaches



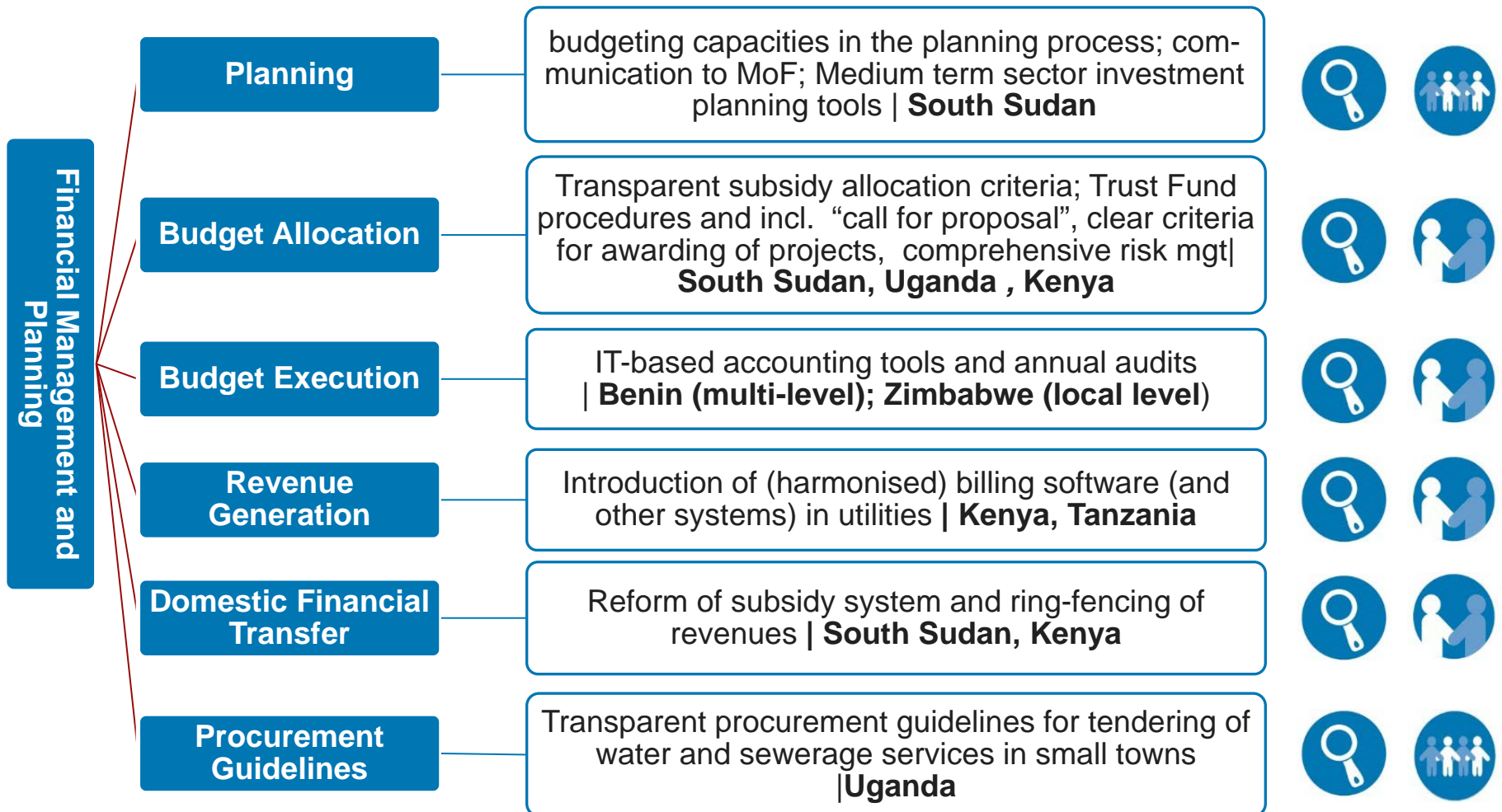

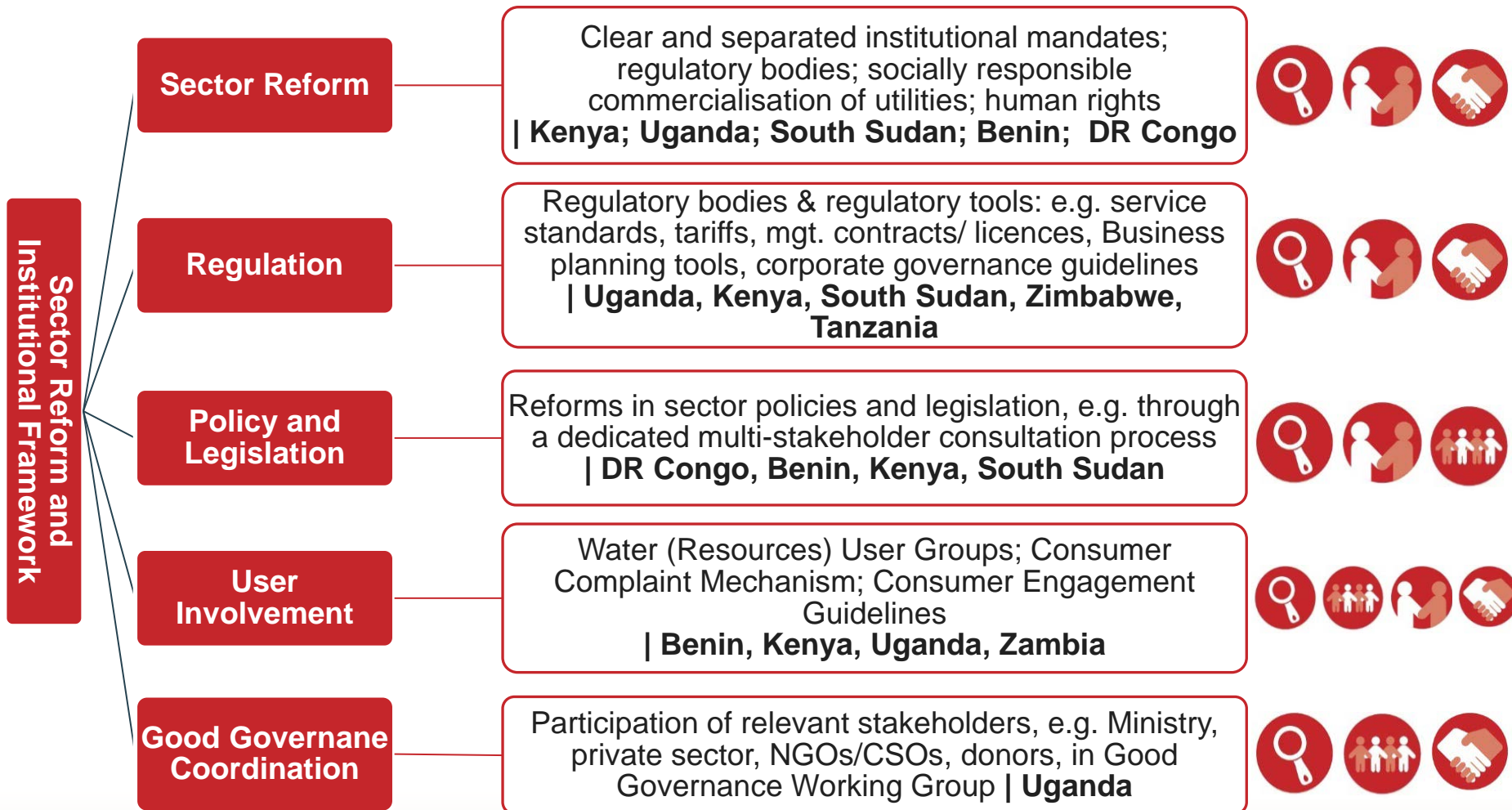

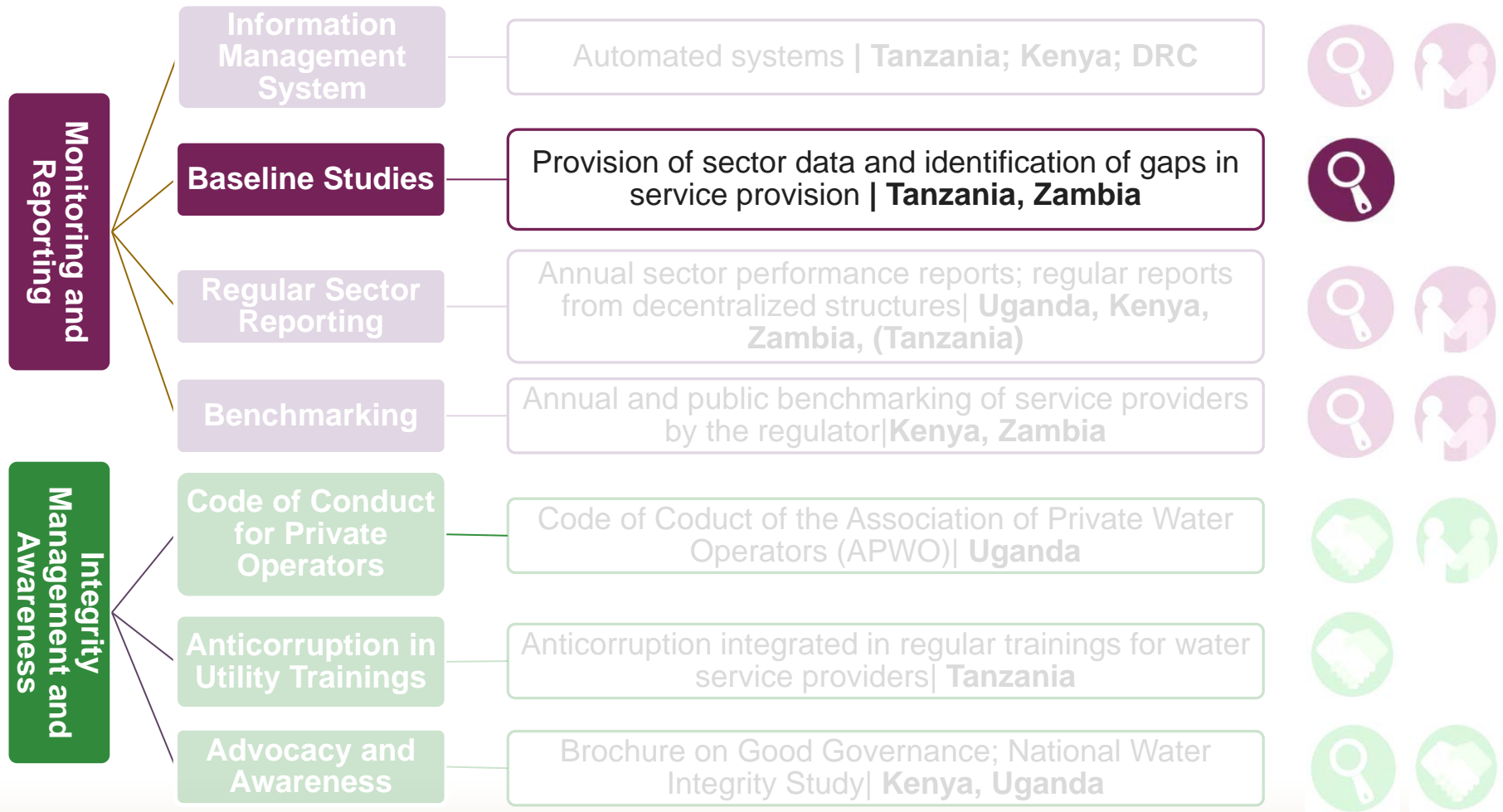

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## Conclusions

- Political will and ownership as key success factors.
- Identify “champions” within the partner institutions and choose approaches in line with the partners’ agenda.

- Use your entry points (reform topics & relationships of trust).
